

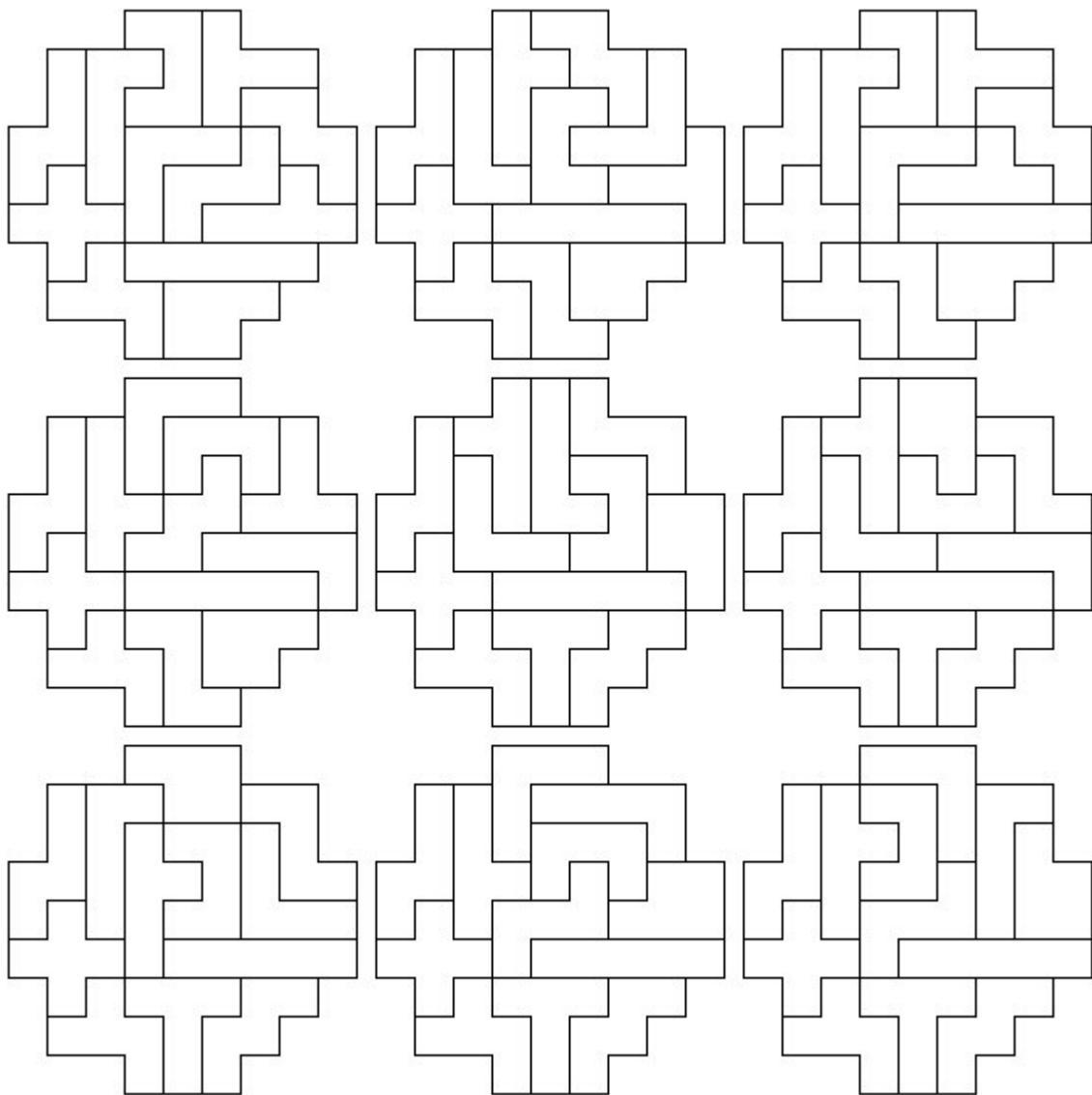
# The San Andreas Puzzle (2)

The published article showed one of the nine possible solutions. The remaining nine solutions are presented in Figure 2. As you can see, the left three pentominoes are always identical. Also the limited number of locations for the I-pentomino is interesting.
